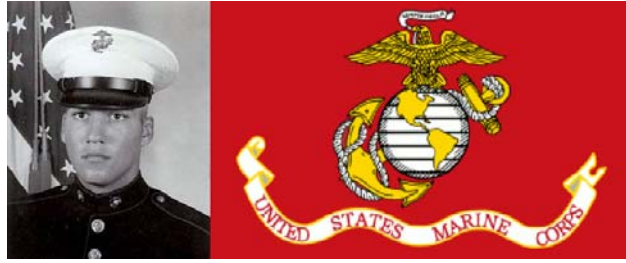


Marine Service/Law School Scholarship Application Form

- For a law student attending (or accepted and planning to attend) an accredited law school and is or has had a family member in the Marine Corps.
- Entrants must submit a 1-3 page essay describing their experience and the impact of the Marine service on their family.
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen and 18 years or older.
- Academic achievement demonstrated through a cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 from undergraduate or current law school work.
- Proof of service for Marine Corps' member

Essay Instructions:

Please submit a one to three (1-3) page typed essay describing how your life has been impacted through the service and sacrifice to your family. Please attach your essay as a separate document.

Award:

- Scholarship is to be used exclusively for law school tuition and/or books.
- A check for \$1,000 will be made payable to the award recipient's law school to cover these expenses.
- Recipient is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.
- Award recipient will be notified of the selection on or about July 31, 2016
